

Biography for Dr. Young Kyun Kim



Since August 1999, Dr. Kim has held the position of Senior Vice President, Global Standards and Research, Telecommunication Networks, Samsung Electronics. He has successfully managed global standards teams for nine years and now, as an Adviser, he focuses on 3G evolution, mobile & broadcasting convergence services, and Mobile WiMAX evolution targeting IMT-Advanced systems. He has profound experience and an extensive network in global R&D outsourcing with world-class academia and research institutes.

Dr. Kim holds several global standards leadership positions. He is the Chairman of APT Wireless Forum, a Vice Chair of ITU-T SG 19 and an IEEE Standards Association Board Member. In 2007, he was also nominated to the IEEE SA Board of Governors.

Before joining Samsung Electronics, Dr. Kim gained 20 years experience in the wireless telecommunication industry in R&D and standards area in the USA. He held the positions of R&D Manager at GTE Corp. and of ITU-R Program Director at INTELSAT, Washington, DC.

Dr. Kim has been a Senior Member of IEEE since 1984 and published 60 technical papers, and has presented more than 70 papers in IEEE and global conferences. In 2006, he published a book entitled "4G Roadmap and Emerging Communication Technologies" with Artech House, UK.

He holds a B.S. from Seoul National University, Korea, an M.S. from Rutgers University, NJ and a Ph.D. from Duke University, NC, USA, all in E.E.
